Facts about the canal...



- 🍁 The Rideau Canal is a series of rivers and lakes, connected by canals (less than 10% of it is actually canal)
- 🍁 The whole waterway is a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- 🍁 It stretches 202km (125 miles) from Ottawa to Kingston
- 🍁 It takes about 43hours to travel its length
- 🍁 There are 45 locks, all manned and operated by friendly lock keepers. The doors and sluice controls are manually operated by hand-crank.
- 🍁 Locks are open 9am to 6pm in Summer, 10am - 4pm in Spring and Autumn
- 🍁 The boating season runs from mid-May to mid-October
- 🍁 Ottawa - is Canada's capital city. Brimming with museums, world class restaurants and tourist attractions.

- 🍁 Le Boat's Canada's program goes on sale in **May 2017** which is when long haul flights start to go on sale for the following year
- 🍁 The first Le Boat departure will be **May 2018**
- 🍁 Only Le Boat's new Horizon models will be available in Canada
(in 2018, we will have 4x Horizon, 4x Horizon 2-S, 4x Horizon 3 and 4x Horizon 4)
- 🍁 There are no other boating operators on the Rideau Canal like Le Boat
